

OUT & ABOUT WITH JOSH JOHNSON

JOSH JOHNSON (1987) IS A MULTIDISCIPLINARY ARTIST FROM LOS ANGELES WHOSE CHOREOGRAPHIC PRACTICE EXPLORES THE SPACE BETWEEN POST-CONTEMPORARY DANCE AND VIRTUOSITY. 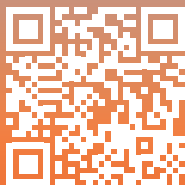
